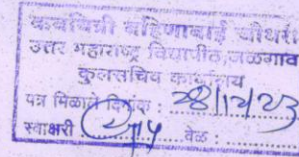



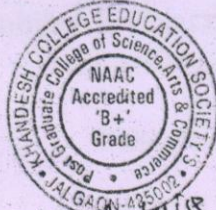

KCE Society's Post Graduate College of Science, Arts and Commerce, Jalgaon Feedback by stake holder about curriculum of the various subjects (for M. Sc.'s.)

(For 2022-23)

1. M. Sc. (Organic Chemistry and Analytical Chemistry):

- i. On job training should be included at final year.
- ii. In order to increase the academic flexibility, choice based /selective /elective courses has to be consider as mentioned in **National Education Policy (NEP)**
- iii. Modern and advanced techniques of analysis should be added in syllabus.
- iv. Addition of Simulation programming for chemical process increases the job opportunities.
- v. Problem solving sessions should be added in evaluation process.
- vi. There should be reform in syllabus considering students' learning level.

2. M. Sc. (Microbiology):

- i. Industrial visit should be made mandatory to give the students a direct view of the career.
- ii. Clinical pathological trainings to the students should be added in syllabus.
- iii. Case study and recent research should be considered in the curriculum.
- iv. On job training should be included at final year.
- v. In order to increase the academic flexibility like choice based /selective /elective courses has to be consider as mentioned in **National Education Policy (NEP)**

3. M. Sc. (Biotechnology):


- i. The courses need up gradation with respect to new developments in the various fields of Biotechnology.
- ii. The curriculum should include soft-skill training focusing on employability.
- iii. Industrial visit should be made mandatory to give the students a direct view of the careers.
- iv. More hands-on training is required in wet lab and bioinformatics

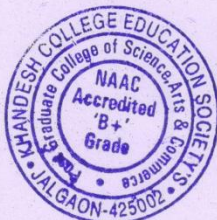
4. M. Sc. (Mathematics/ Statistics):


- i. LaTeX is a high-quality typesetting system; it includes features designed for the production of technical and scientific documentation in mathematics hence, two week training of LaTeX to students should be incorporated in curriculum.
- ii. One dedicated unit in each course should be focused on the preparation of competitive examinations. like NET /SET/UPSC/MPSC/GET to increase the opportunities in career.
- iii. In order to make students computer savvy required for industrial jobs, the programming languages like pythons and sci-lab must include in the syllabus.

5. M. Com. (Commerce):

- i. Internship program should be added
- ii. Skill Development issues should be added in the syllabus.
- iii. Curricula should focus on risk management of sustainability.



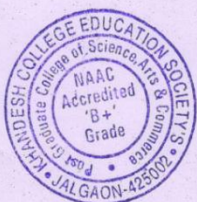
