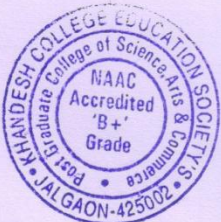
Respected Sir,

Feedback by stake holder about curriculum of the various subjects (for M. Sc.'s.)
(For 2023-24)

1. M. Sc. (Organic Chemistry and Analytical Chemistry):

- i. On job training should be included at final year.
- ii. In order to increase the academic flexibility, choice based /selective /elective courses has to be consider as mentioned in **National Education Policy (NEP)**
- iii. Modern and advanced techniques of analysis should be added in syllabus.
- iv. Addition of Simulation programming for chemical process increases the job opportunities.
- v. Problem solving sessions should be added in evaluation process.

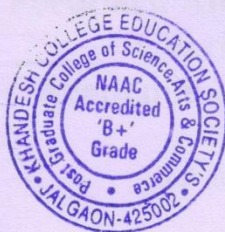
2. M. Sc. (Microbiology):

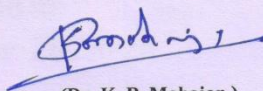
- i. Industrial visit should be made mandatory to give the students a direct view of the career.
- ii. Clinical pathological trainings to the students should be added in syllabus.
- iii. Case study and recent research should be considered in the curriculum.
